Applications must be received by 4:00 pm on October 13, 2023. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applicants will be notified of their status no later than November 20, 2023.

ATTENDANCE/PARTICIPATION: Full attendance at all day sessions (8:00 am - 5:00 pm), the opening & closing retreats (two full days plus one overnight) is required. Only two absences will be allowed for personal/work situations. Please note day sessions will be on one Wednesday each month in 2023. The schedule will be available online by July 1, 2023.
TUITION: Tuition for the Class Experience is \$5,700 and Rising Leaders program is \$5,500. Tuition is non-refundable. Upon acceptance, a \$1,000 non-refundable payment toward tuition is required no later than December 8, 2023. Unless special arrangements have been made with the CEO, remainder of tuition must be received in full prior to the opening retreat. Full Tuition payment is expected by January 5, 2024.
SCHOLARSHIPS: A limited number of partial tuition scholarships are available and are determined by need. Candidates wishing to apply for tuition assistance must complete the Application for Financial Assistance form, available on the LB website, www.leadershipbuffalo.org/apply and submit it with their application by October 13, 2023 to be considered.
