#### COMMITMENT

ATTENDANCE/PARTICIPATION: Full attendance at all day sessions (8:00 am - 5:00 pm), the opening & closing retreats (two full days plus one overnight) is required. Only two absences will be allowed for personal/work situations. Please note day sessions will be on one Wednesday each month in 2019. The schedule will be available online by July 1, 2019.

TUITION: Tuition for the **Rising Leaders program is \$3,900**. Tuition for the **Class Experience program is \$4,900**. Tuition is non-refundable. Upon acceptance, a \$1,000 non-refundable payment toward tuition is required no later than December 6, 2019. Unless special arrangements have been made with the CEO, remainder of tuition must be received in full prior to the opening retreat.

SCHOLARSHIPS: A limited number of partial tuition scholarships are available and are determined by need. Candidates wishing to apply for tuition assistance must complete the Application for Financial Assistance form, available on the LB website, <a href="www.leadershipbuffalo.org/apply">www.leadershipbuffalo.org/apply</a> and submit it with their application by October 18, 2019 to be considered.
